What is it?

The Employee Assistance Program provided by Perspectives, Ltd. and accessed through your benefits is a resource for you and your family members. Personal issues and concerns happen to all of us and usually are easy to handle. There are times, however, when these issues are overwhelming and help is required.

Sometimes the hesitancy to call the EAP is fear of the unknown. What do I say? What can I expect? Most times we ask the person calling to come in and talk with a counselor. At that first meeting, the counselor explains the program and confidentiality laws and the discussion of the issues proceed from there. The counselor will try to touch on all aspects of a person's life and assess the situation from all of the information given. From this point the client and the counselor together make a plan to help deal with the issues that the individual is experiencing. There may be a need for additional referrals or maybe a few sessions with the EAP is all that is necessary.
